





# Fun At-Home Activities

Let your child set the table for dinner tonight. Count Easter eggs with your child.	Have your child find 10 circles in the kitchen.	Listen to music with your child.	Visit the library and let your child check out a book.	Read to your child at least 15 minutes	Give your child a bowl of Cheerios to count. Save them to use tomorrow.	String the Cheerios onto a piece of yarn to make a bracelet.
Take a walk with your child and look for signs of spring.	Have your child draw a Spring picture.	Watch birds with your child and discuss their feet, feathers, eating habits....
