

Maryland AskUsNow! is a statewide library chat service. **It's available 24/7.** We provide answers to questions, offer research guidance, and supply help finding information online.

AskUsNow! is a free service, and can be used with or without a library card.

How Can You Help My Students?

With Whom Am I Chatting?

You're chatting with librarians across
Maryland. During times that we're busy or not online, you may also chat with a librarian from another state (or even another country).



What About Privacy?

copy of what you learned
during the chat.

How Does AskUsNow! Work?

1. Ask a question.


To get started, go to www.askusnow.info, or find our chat box on your local library's website. We're here 24/7 to help!

Question
Hello! I need help finding information

2. Have a conversation.


The librarian may ask for more information about your question. As they search, they will tell you about where they are looking and why they are choosing certain resources.

You're encouraged to review resources as the librarian sends them.



3. Save your information.

You found great information together—fabulous! If you have not entered your email address, you can do so at the end of the chat. You'll receive a copy of your chat session, including any links the librarian shared.



How We'll Help

- We teach students how to do research, or provide resources that will help them understand how to do research better.
- Chat librarians **locate quality and trustworthy sources** from around the Internet and from library-specific resources. (We may even use a print book now and then.)
- If students are in a rush or have a complex question, we may offer to
 follow up with more resources by email. Teachers are welcome to supply
 their own email address in lieu of a student's.
- We'll help students in a safe online space. We may ask students for more information about the assignment, but not about themselves. They can anonymously receive a transcript of their session by entering their email address after the chat has ended.
- We're ready to help your students on assignments and projects.

Help Us to Help You!

- We know time is fleeting. Students should be ready to chat for 15-20 minutes. This will give us time to thoroughly help.
- Encourage students to have a clear question ready.
 We may ask for more information - such as their grade and if they have a library card - to help us find the best information and resources.
- Pair up students. This leads to quicker response times.
