Techniques we will explore:

- Color theory and value – Landscape
- Blending – Flowers
- Details and texture – Birds
- Loose and flowy – Jelly fish

(All the materials listed are from Michael's, however you can find paper and brush packs at Wal-Mart, also you can find most of this at Hobby Lobby.)

Materials Needed:

- Water color paper
Brand – Canson, 30 sheets 140 lbs
Size 9 X 12
Aisle 46
Michael's cost \$11.99
- Water colors
Water color disc Brand - PRANG
8 colors -we will be mixing colors so 8 is enough
Aisle 43 below the brushes
Michael's cost \$7.99
- Water color tubes
Brand – Artist Loft
12 color tubes
End cap Aisle 43
Michael's cost \$5.99



Water color pencils THESE ARE AWESOME

Brand – Staedtler

12 count

Aisle with markers and art pencils on the bottom

Michael's cost \$11.99

I would buy these as an extra after you purchase other water colors, but they are super easy to use and fun!



- Water color brushes**

Pack of brushes

Brand – Artist Loft

Rounds

You can get blue, purple, or yellow handles – just make sure they are rounds.

Aisle 22 over by craft paint

Michael's cost \$5.99



Individual brushes

Aisle 43 past the paints

Look on top for watercolor brushes and then you can choose the level. Any will work. Look for rounds.

Best to get a #2, #4, and #6. Cost varies. Use a coupon if you can. If you only buy one get a #4 round.



Size is listed on the brush just below the tip.



Other Materials Needed:

2 cup of water, paper towels, scratch paper, plate for mixing colors, pencil, eraser, regular yellow masking tape.

For texture you will need - salt granules, rubbing alcohol, small squirt bottle, tooth picks.
